Church Update

In preparation for the gradual re-opening of our two churches here in Kilburn, the Parish Team are proposing the following :

Only when we get the green light to proceed

Quex Road will open from 10am-1pm each weekday for quiet prayer only. Sacred Heart will also open from 11am-1pm on Sunday.



Percy Road will open from

10am-11am on Sunday Morning for quiet prayer only.



During these times you will be able to enter either church to pray quietly or light a candle.

This is the **first** stage of re-opening of places of worship. It is very important that at this stage that **NO** communal prayer takes place, so we ask you to refrain from saying the Rosary or the Divine Mercy Chaplet in small groups.

After you have left the building, one of our volunteers will clean the area around where you have been and if you wish to light a candle they will have the lighters for you.



Please use the hand sanitisers, available in both churches, on entering and exiting the building.

We will also have face masks available for those who wish to use them whilst in church. Please make sure that you dispose of them in the bins provided.



It is very important that we adhere to these regulations for the sake of everyone.
