



## CODE OF ETHICS AND CONDUCT FOR VOLUNTEERS AND PARISH STAFF

Personal statement for old and new volunteers:

I understand that as a volunteer, I am a representative of Sacred Heart Church, Quex Road, and more importantly the kingdom of God. I agree to conduct myself in a manner that models for others an active and growing Christian faith. I understand that the community I serve will look to me for direction and guidance that supports their growing faith in Jesus Christ.

I understand that I am here to assist in carrying out the mission of our Parish. I understand that in accepting this ministry role I agree to become actively responsible for providing a safe, secure, and enjoyable time for every member of this community (Sacred Heart Church, Ouex Road), as well as for my fellow ministry members.

While acting in my capacity as a Ministries Volunteer, I will

- 1. Treat everyone with respect, patience, integrity, courtesy, dignity, openness, honesty and consideration.
- 2. Respect the rights and advance the welfare of each person.
- 3. As a volunteer, I will assume the full burden of responsibility for establishing and maintaining clear, appropriate boundaries in every situation
- 4. ...not engage in physical, psychological, written, or verbal harassment of office staff, other volunteers, or parishioners and I will also not tolerate such harassment by other Church staff or volunteers.
- 5. ...at all times, provide a professional environment that is free from any kind of verbal intimidation or harassment.
- 6. All volunteers must reframe from discussing personal issues (gossip) about members of this Parish with others who have no need to know?
- 7. Workers and volunteers must treat all people of all races, religions, and cultures with respect and consideration.

I understand that any violation of this code may be grounds for removal as a worker or volunteer within the Parish.

I also understand that this policy is subject to change at any time.
