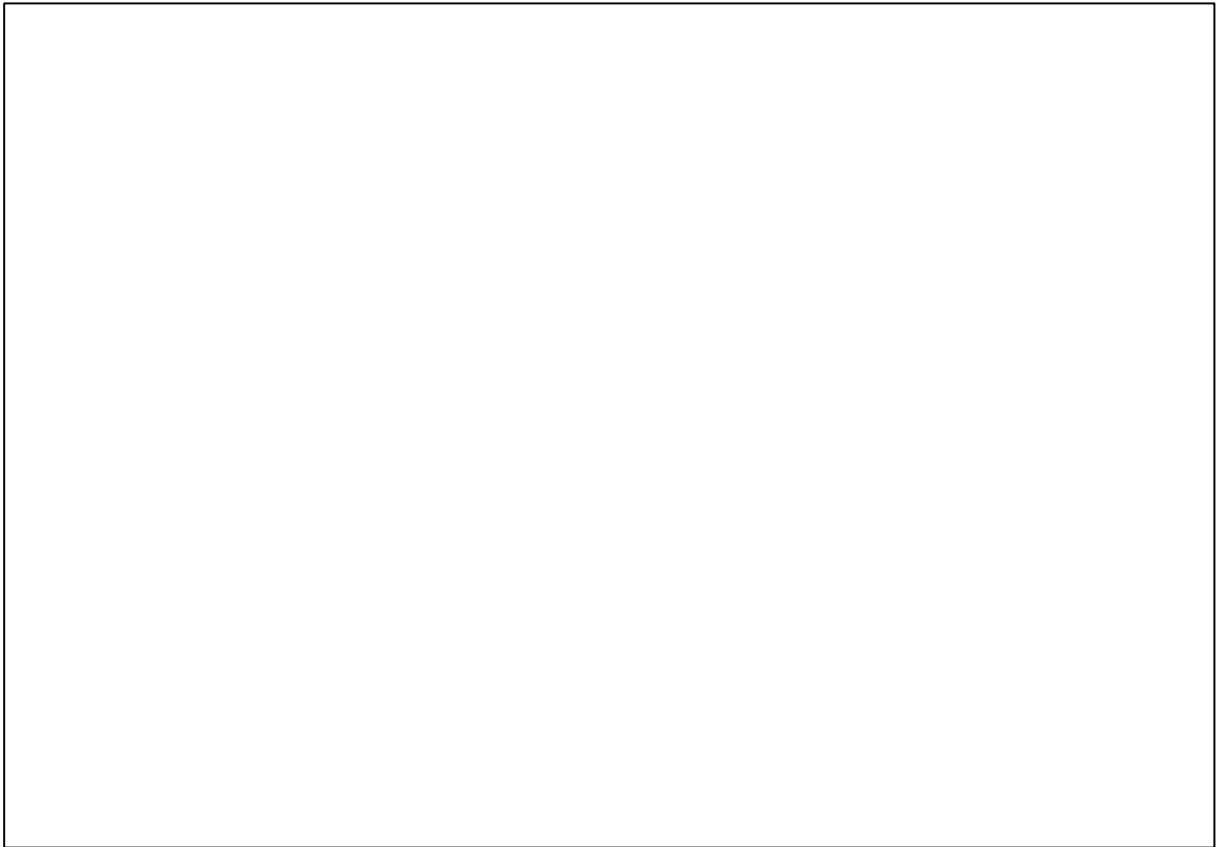

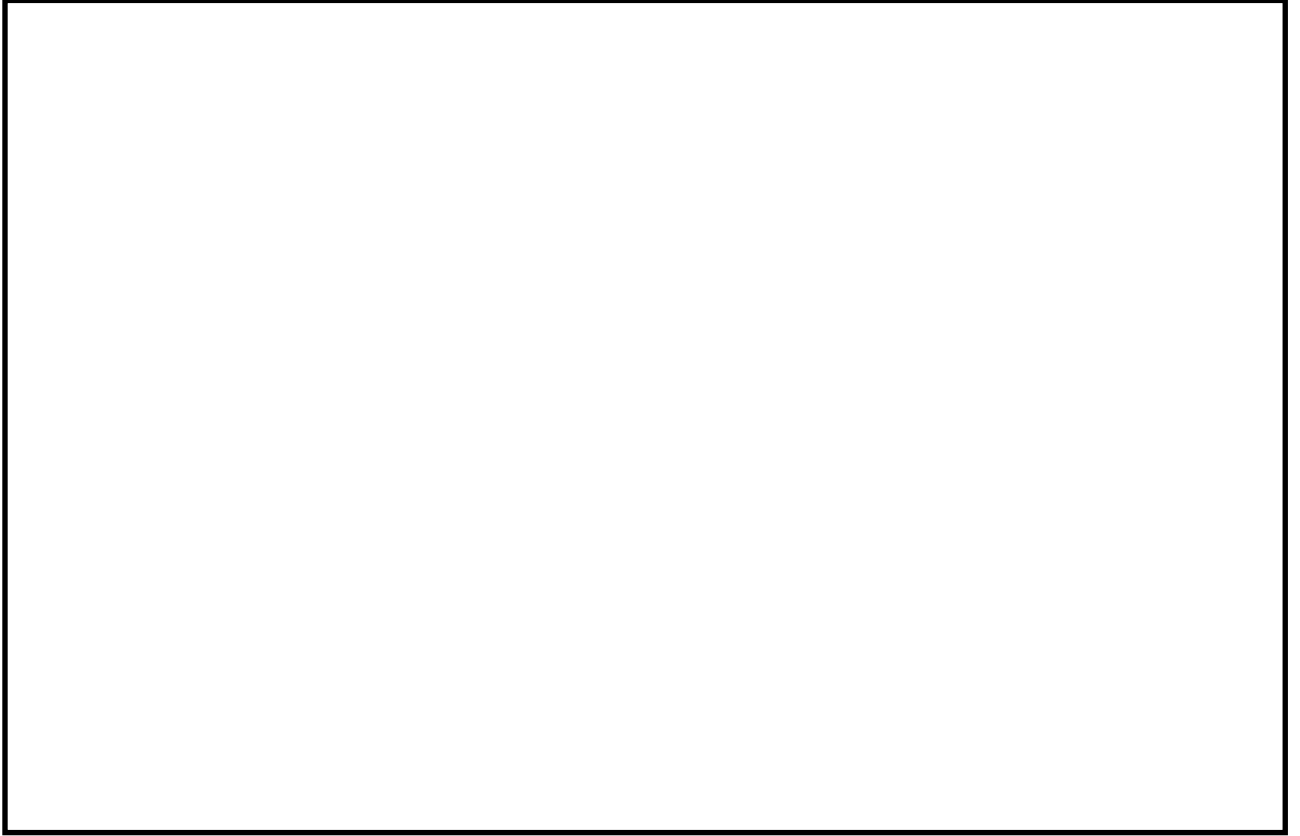

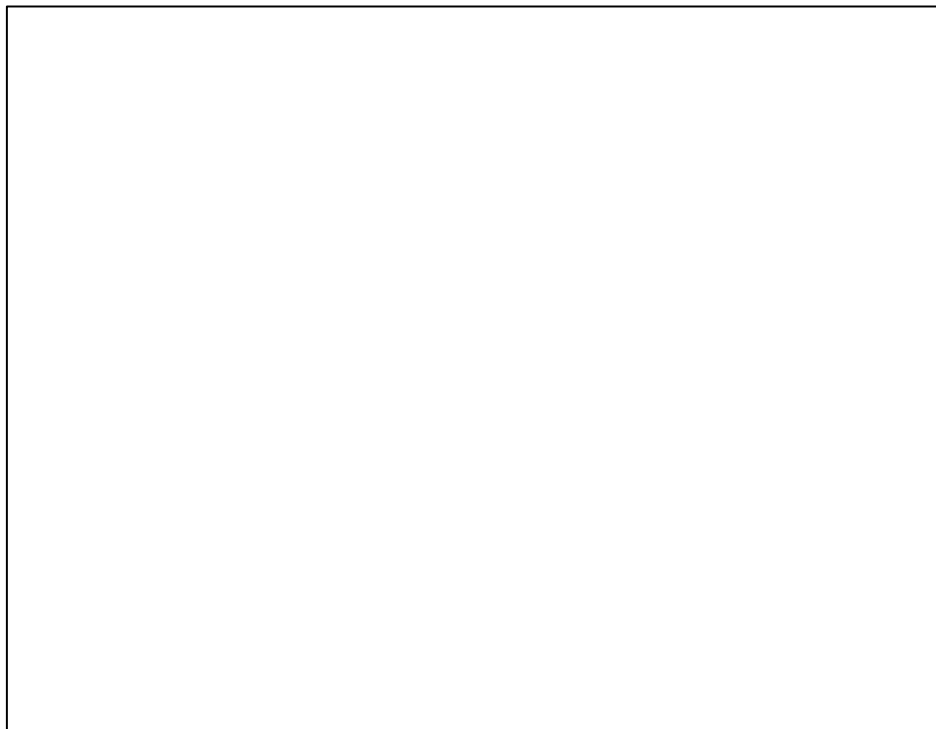

Jesus is a special person. He lived with Mary and Joseph. He lived in Nazareth. When he grew up he told his friends

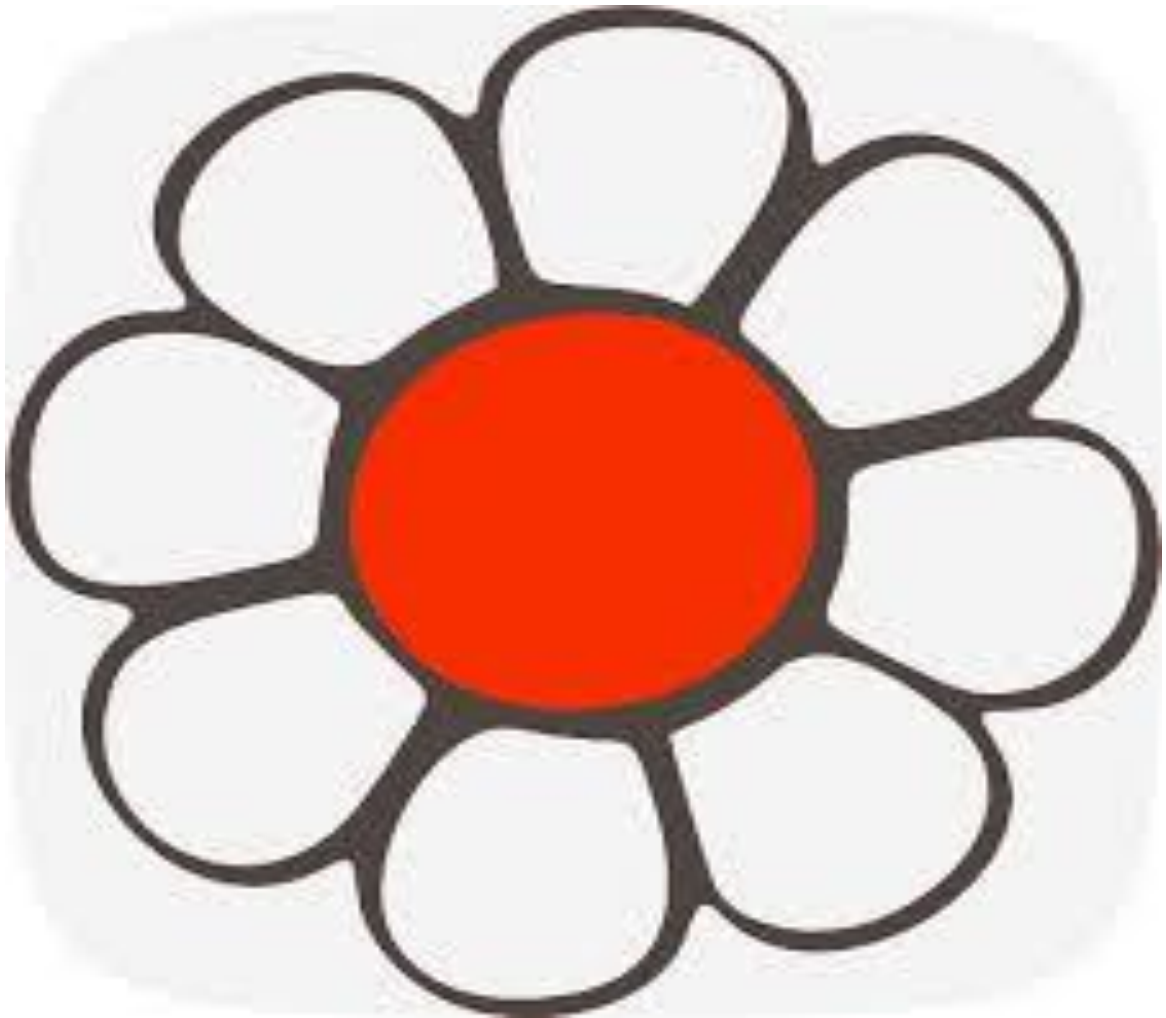

Jerusalem riding on a donkey.

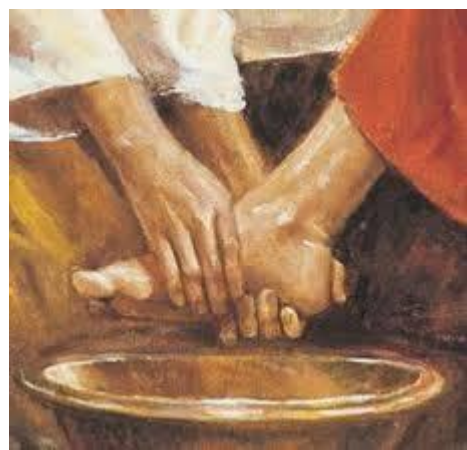
The crowds were so happy to see him.

Jesus gathered his friends together and he did something really unusual. He washed their feet! He said that he was giving them an example so that they would take care of one another too

On Holy Thursday, the night before he died Jesus had a meal with his friends.

We call this meal the **Last Supper**

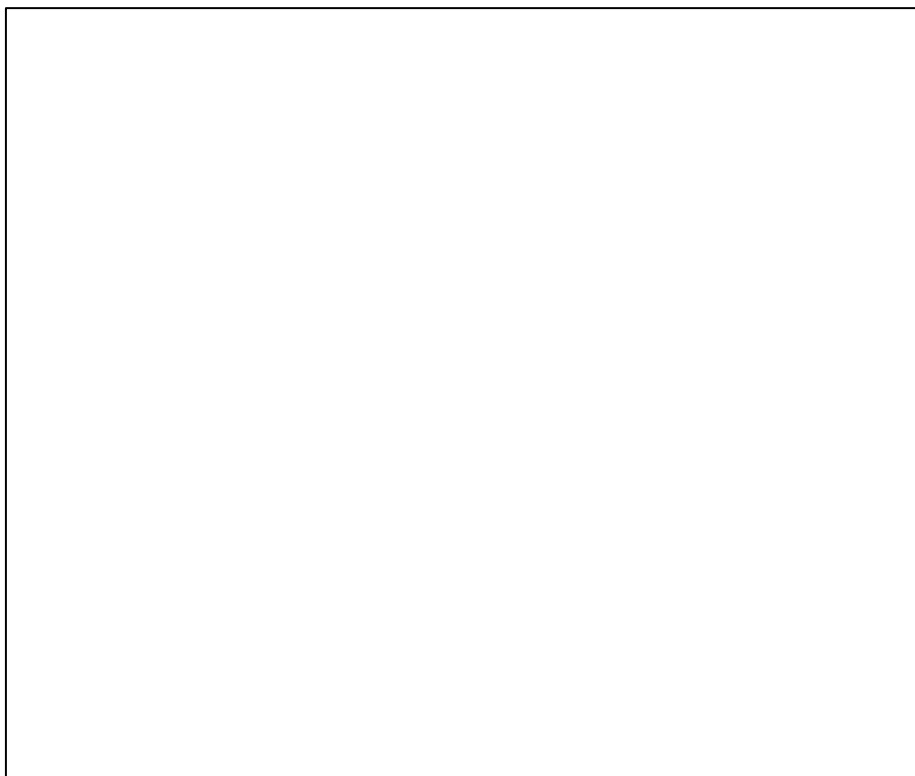
