



In June 2020 Jesus will welcome me to my First Communion Celebration. At this celebration I will receive his Body in communion.


Jesus is a special person. He lived with Mary and Joseph. He lived in Nazareth. When he grew up he told his friends

On Palm Sunday Jesus went to


Jerusalem riding on a donkey.

The crowds were so happy to see him.


They cut palm branches from the trees

Good Friday


On Good Friday we remember that Jesus died on the cross
